By the Burgesses of Assembly October 15 1694

Voted that Peter Ferdinand of Charles County Abraham Amros and Abraham
his Son of Kent County Herman Van Burkelo Nicholas de Montague Henry
Suyter and Jacob Suyter junior of Cecil County that unless they take the Oaths
appointed by Act of Parliament instead of the Oaths of Allegiance and Supremacy
and sign the Test and transmit the same to his Excellency the Governor & Council
before the next Sessions of Assembly the Bill as to their Naturalization to be void
to them that refuse to take the said Oaths and sign the Test
