did not properly belong to them was thereupon taken into Consider-
ation by this Board

And the Burgesses belonging to the said County sent for to
see what they had to say thereto who accordingly appeared and the
said Matter fully debated and Unquod and then the said Burgess
es withdrew

Resolved and Ordered that the Court House lately begun to
be built in Somerset County by Order of the Commissioners of the said
County be out of hand finished and that the Courts therein held be
kept and that an Order of this Board of the 30th of July last past
be null and void

Produced the following Supersent from the House of Burgesses
to this Board viz

By the Burgesses of Assembly October 18th 1694
Proposed whether all Ships remaining here in this Province
after the Fleet have sailed have Liberty to sail or to be kept to go in
a Fleet this House doth think fit that they may be cleared by the
discretion of his Excellency the Governor to depart this Province as
they shall be ready

By the Burgesses of Assembly Oct^r 17th 1694

This House doth think fit that the Allowance already proposed is
sufficient to their Majesty's Councillors of this Province and that the
Country is not in Capacity to allow them any more

The House doth concur with his Excellency the Governor and allow
ed the Proposals of several Letters to be writ to several Persons as by a
List sent to the House of the same

Ordered by this House that their Majesty's Councillors be paid what
is allowed them this present General Assembly in the County whereon
