

110 Speaker went to his Excellency the latter of the several aforementioned Acts presented to us a present together with us the forth of the sum of 1062928 Pounds of Tobacco upon the Intublements of this Province for defraying the publick Charge thereof likewise presented to

October 18<sup>th</sup> 1694

Came before the honorable Sir Thomas Lawrence Baronet and Col<sup>l</sup> Nicholas Greenberry two of their Majestys Justices of the S<sup>u</sup>perior Court Chancery and John Evans Gent who did in the Presence of the Generall Assembly under the Body for Body that William Bundy and George Mason Prisoners under Sentence of Death for the Murder of 110 John Payne shall appear and be forth coming to stand and abide his Sacred Majestys determination where ever they shall be thereunto required by his Excellency the Governour with which they both declared themselves contented

The laws passed the Seal and are thus entered viz  
On the behalf of their Majestys King William & Queen Mary  
I will these to be Laws Francis Nicholson

Then his Exc<sup>y</sup> is pleased to tell them that in the first place he did in their Majestys behalf thank them for their great care and labor promoting the worship of God and their Majestys Interest by making such Laws as he hoped would be for the general Good and Safety of this their Majestys Province and he further recommended it to them that they should according to their respective Places and Stations see them carefully put in Execution

He also thanks them for their many favourable and kind Expressions towards himself telling them that he had done no more than what he thought he was Obliged to do both in Conscience and duty and that he should always endeavour to be serviceable both to their Majestys and this their Province to the utmost of his Power

Afterwards his Excellency was pleased to declare his Resolution of adjourning the Assembly to the last day of February next ensuing withal Acquainting them that if there should be occasion for their sitting at that time he would give out his Proclamation to give notice thereof and if it would be only requisite a sufficient number should meet to us in the House and so his Excellency Ordered the Speaker to return to the House and adjourn it accordingly and the Assembly was adjourned to the last Tuesday of February next ensuing
