Voted that his Excellency appoint such Person as he shall think fit to
Inspect into the Bonds and Books belonging to the Commissaries Office and
that they be conveyed to Ann Arundell Town by the next Sessions of Assembly
And that the loose Papers left at S^t Marys in the Secretaries Office be well secured
and conveyed to Ann Arundell Town by the next Sessions of Assembly and to
be secured with the rest of the Records
