The following message sent to the House by Colonel Henry Jones and Thomas Brook Esq. Viz

By his Excellency the Governor and Council in Assembly October 31st 1698 Promised that the House give order to the Committee for stating and examining the Accounts that they particularly examine and state the Account of the Treasurer ...

- 1 If they be in one magazine they are liable to be blown up as the Accident at the Chancellors House at Saint Marys and late Instances in Virginia
2 They are liable to be seized upon by an Enemy or upon an Invasion
3 It will put the Country to Great Charge and Trouble upon any sudden course to distribute them
