meet any sculking Indian which could give no good account of themselves, that he should be directed to bring them before Colonel Addison to be examined and dealt withall according to his Direction. Resolved that upon application to his Excellency

a good Quantity of fuses and Musquitts be sent to Colonel Addison to be distributed upon among the poor Inhabitants on the Frontiers. —

The Council desire his Excellency will be pleased that in case any further Mischiefe happen to be done by Indians that he will be pleased to take ^{such} speedy care thereupon in his Direction he shall thinke fit. —
