His Majesty in Council is pleased to signify  
by Disapprobation and disallowance of the  
said Law and according to the Majesty's Pleasure  
the said Law and hereby repealed and  
declared void and of none Effect.

Which being read and considered and divers  
Arguments and Debates had thereupon  
His Majesty is pleased to order the Council  
whether they do not think  
it advisable that he should immediately give  
a Proclamation Signifying the repeal of  
the said Law. To which they severally  
agree Answer and Advise by Letters under  
the issuing of such Proclamation for the  
following reason - viz.

First In regard there is not a full Council  
at this time, there being only three present  
at the Board, and the others being so  
remote that they cannot well be called  
together in a short time.

That they being a Matter of great and  
weighty moment which may have strange  
Influences on the Courts of Law and  
Justice
