demolished there.

Mr John Dantrey having produced a Commission
from the Hon^{ble} Court of the King
to be Collector of probomech trade & Duties
appointed by Act of Parliament instead of
the Oath of Allegiance & Supremacy -
Aded to him as likewise the Oath appointed
by the Act of 9th 10th years of the present
Maj^{ty} Richard subtitled an Act for
preventing Frauds and regulating Affairs
in the Plantation Trade which he took
and likewise subscribed the Test Association
having given Bond in England for the
faithfull Execution of his Office.

Then was produced and read a Commission
from the Hon^{ble} Court of the King
to William Bladon to be Surveyor of
the port of Annapolis whereupon
the said Oath were aded to him which
he took and also subscribed the Test
Association - And putted into Bond
with the Hon^{ble} Court of the King
Major William Bladon
faithfull Execution of his Office.
