However he is well come. — He says that
the Emperor if his or his Judiciary were under
any fear or Diffidence, or if any one gave
them ill impressions of any ill respects they
might expect from him, to which the Emperor
says no not any Body. And says that
he would have come before now when they say
but for him, but that the Judiciary that
they say speaks to to bid him come in —
desired him and came not to him but —
went to Nanjott; but that he was now
come in;

He says give them to understand that we
have not any design of Advantage from
them; but that the King desires they
may be kindly used, and that it is most for
their Advantage to live quietly & safely
among us.

Tell them that severall Murders
have been committed of late & divers persons
injured, that we do not certainly know
whom it was that they done it but they say it
was not them — They absolutely deny they
are guilty of any such thing.

He says observe to them that they have
truffled and cutt off and on & broke
their Articles so that it was but reasonable
to suspect them. Tell them he expects they
should be very punctual to what is now
said.
