

following Articles being prepared and read  
were unanimously agreed to be signed by the Subscribers  
as followeth Viz.

Articles of peace and Amity concluded  
and agreed upon between Sir Guy Mordaunt  
Bartholomew Esq<sup>r</sup> Capt<sup>r</sup> Pitt and Governour  
in Chief in and over the City of  
Province of Maryland and the Territory  
therunto belonging & Quotomagnah  
Emperour of Piscataway the 8<sup>th</sup> Day  
of Aprill 1700.

Imp<sup>t</sup>. It is agreed upon that from the Day forward  
there be an inviolable peace and amity between  
His most Excellent Majesty King William the Third of  
England &c and His Subjects the Inhabitants of  
the Province, and the Emperour of Piscataway  
upon the Articles hereafter mentioned to the  
Words End to Endure And that all former  
Acts of Hostility and Damages whatsoever by  
either party suffered be buried in perpetual  
Oblivion.

2<sup>d</sup>ly. That if any Indian Subject to the Said  
Emperour shall hereafter chance to Kill an  
Englishman, the Said Emperour shall be bound  
to deliver such Indian up to the Governour of  
the Province as a prisoner.

3<sup>d</sup>ly. Forasmuch as the English cannot easily  
distinguish one Indian from another, that  
no Indian shall come into any English  
Settlement.
