a person of Probity whose Name may be  
communicated with all Expedition to the said  
Governour or Governour of the Province  
for the time being by his Advice & Direction  
therein.

10<sup>th</sup> July That as a further Testimony of his Majesty's  
grace and Favour shewn unto his Majesty  
they expect protection from him & his  
Government here there be paid by the said  
Empire of a Tribute to his said Majesty  
an Indian Bow and two Arrows to be delivered  
to his Majesty the Governour or the Governour  
for the time being at his residence where so ever  
the same shall happen to be on the first  
Tuesday in April every year successively

11<sup>th</sup> July And lastly as a full and ample proof and  
Assurance of the said Emperours Fidelity  
truth and Sincerity he does solemnly promise  
Engage and oblige himselfe with his Majesty  
to come and live at Jamestown  
within two months time from the Date hereof  
and will do his utmost Endeavour to persuade  
all his Indians to come and live there likewise.  
In confirmation whereof his said Majesty  
the Governour and likewise the said Emperour  
themselves do mutually signeth knowledgeth & deliver  
to each other the foregoing Articles in the presence  
of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Council of his Majesty the Governour  
at the great mess of his Majesty the 9<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1700
