King our self enough of a Tribute to his Majesty
an Indian Bow and two Arrows to be delivered
to his Majesty the Governour or the Governour
for the times being at his Majesty's residence wherefore
the same shall be paid to be on the first
Tuesday in Aprill in every year successively -

11th July - And lastly as a full and ample proofe of and
assurances of the said Queens fidelity truth and
Sincerity she doe solemnly promise Engage &
oblige her selfe with her Judiciary within two
monthly tyme to come and live at Samankey
and that she will do her utmost Endeavour
to persuade and oblige all her Indians to live
there likewise - In Confirmation whereof
his said Majesty the Gov. and likewise his said
husband to the said Queen and Colonel James her
Indaker and she doe mutually
signe acknowledge and deliver to each other
these present Articles this 9th day of Aprill 1700.
