Whereas the King of Great Britain by His Letters under the Great Seal of Great Britain bearing date the 22nd of the 1st of the said month of June 1707 did give power and authority unto the said Council of the said Colonies to send and appoint such and such persons as they should think fit to be Rangers of the said Colonies

That the said Council of the said Colonies do hereby give power and authority unto the said Rangers now appointed being the said Council of the said Colonies to send and appoint such and such persons as they should think fit to be Rangers of the said Colonies and not only to consult with them but also to direct the said Rangers who he had summoned should have all limitations according to the direction of the Act of the said King appointing the said Council of the said Colonies to consult the said Rangers either in keeping out the Rangers now appointed being the said Council of the said Colonies or otherwise as the said Council of the said Colonies shall advise upon which Matters and Deliberate and resolving the said Council of the said Colonies to give the said Rangers the said Protection as given by the said Council of the said Colonies and that the said Rangers be added so that they may Range by force of arms and that they be kept until such time as the said Council of the said Colonies shall think fit to discharge them and that the said Council of the said Colonies be obliged to give the said Rangers the said Protection as given by the said Council of the said Colonies
