It being represented that Capt. Hill had a very convenient
House in the Town of Chincoteague to abt. And that Capt.
Hill's House be fitted up for the Indians to reside in
according to his Excellency's Instructions.

Ordered that Capt. William H. Morris and Mr. John Mathews
receive and enroll as well the English as Indians Names
that are already come in with the Emperor of Portugal
to come in according to His Message this day proposed to
be sent to the Indians and that the said Captain give the
Indians Notice not to travel above of Eastern Branch.

Resolved that the Articles of peace with the Indians
of Manticoke and the other Adjacent Islands be suspended
and forasmuch as we have reason to suspect some
treachery from some Indians that inhabit here and the
other Nations that the Indians hereby fall from their Indians
on this side the Bay. Let all Injury stand to be done
upon any Violence or injury offered by other Indians.

I Vizuald there was a Proposal made by Assembly
for paying the Publick and Foreign Drayns Money
and not in Tobacco. This Question is referred to the
Adviser of the Board if they think it would be proper to
pay Tobacco with to make to which the Genl. of the Board
Council do say that they do not believe it would have
any such effect that there will be the same quantity of
Tobacco made as with tobacco before.

After having Appointed Commissioners
for a Person and the Day represented to be paid at
late very well and orderly behaved themselves.
