 debate whether all the Laws desired to be in

 merated in the repealing and Confirming
 Laws made last Assembly.

In answer to which it was the opinion of
 the House that by this way Order in Council
 of the 30th of November 1699 None but the Laws
 Enumerated and particularly mentioned in
 the said Repealing the Laws of this Pro-
 vince were thereby repealed. However they
 desired to have Copies of the said Paragraphs
 of this Order sent and leave to consider
 in their House which being given and
 they took leave and repaired to the House.

Ordered that Notice be given to the
 Justices of the several County Courts
 that every time Court they take notice
 of the respective Statutes according to the
