

T U E S D A Y, February 18, 1777.

THE senate met according to adjournment. The same members present as on yesterday.
The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The conferees by this house appointed for the purpose, bring in the following report:
By the COMMITTEE of both houses appointed to compleat the military appointment of our quota of the army, and settle the rank of the officers.

YOUR committee have taken into their consideration the proceedings of the commissioners appointed by the late convention to go to the camp, and have, upon the most mature reflection on all circumstances, made out a list of the field and other officers down to a first lieutenant inclusive, belonging to seven battalions, part of the quota of this state, leaving the eighth battalion for the German and rifle companies; which list is hereunto annexed.

Your committee have also filled up the subalterns, where the field officers could be consulted, or where they had received commissions from the commissioners or the council of safety, leaving the other subalterns to be recommended by the field officers of each battalion.

Your committee are of opinion, that the rank cannot be finally adjusted, because of the battalion of Germans and riflemen, without consulting general Smallwood, and think the adjustment thereof may be well referred to a future day, when he may conveniently attend.

All which is submitted to the consideration of the honourable houses.
