DOCTOR SMITH informed the Visitors, that, in compliance with their request, he had enclosed a copy of the act of founding WASHINGTON COLLEGE, to his Excellency General Washington, in a letter, of which a copy follows:

May it please your Excellency,

BY order, and in behalf, of the VISITORS OF KENT COUNTY SCHOOL, I have the honour to enclose to your Excellency an ACT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, for erecting a college at Chester, for the benefit of the eastern shore or peninsula between Chesapeake and Delaware bays; which they have dignified with the auspicious name of "WASHINGTON COLLEGE IN THE STATE OF MARYLAND, in honourable and perpetual memory of his EXCELLENCY GENERAL WASHINGTON, the illustrious and virtuous COMMANDER in chief of the armies of the United States."
