The bill, entitled, An act to creek a public gaol in Anna-Arundel county, was read the fe

cond time and will pass with the provoced amendment.

Amendment proposed. At the end of the bill add, "And be it enacted, That the said justices of Anne-Arundel county shall also apply to the same purpose, the sum of eleven hundred and fifty-three pounds fixteen shillings and five-pence, for which a certificate hath been obtained on interest, for damages heretofore done to the old prison by the continental foldiers; and also shalk have full power and authority to fell all the materials belonging to the old prison that may still be left on the spot where said prison stood, and apply the money arising from such sale towards the creeting a new prison on such ground as may be purchased in pursuance of this act."
