- No. 78. A Supplement to the act, entitled, An act for enlarging the power of the high court of chancery.
- No. 79. An act for the relief of John Stevens, of Dorchester county, late collector of the tax.
- No. 80. An act to alter and amend the law in certain cases.
- No. 81. An act respecting surplus lands.
- No. 82. An act to establish a supplementary fund to raise the sum of money required of this state by the resolve of congress of the eighteenth of April seventeen hundred and eighty-three.
- No. 83. An act to raise the supplies for the year seventeen hundred and eighty-six.
- No. 84. An act respecting executions against certain public debtors.
- No. 85. An act respecting the loan made by this state with Messieurs Nicholas and Jacob Vanstaphorsts, of Amsterdam, merchants.
- No. 86. An act to make valid the proceedings of the vestry of St. Peter's parish in Talbot county, and for other purposes therein mentioned.
- No. 87. An act concerning jurisdiction.
- No. 88. An act to vest certain powers in the governor and the council.
- No. 89. An act for the payment of the journal of accounts.
