Mr. Hammond, from the committee to whom the bill, entitled, An act to allow further time for collecting the balances due Thomas O'Bryon, late sheriff and collector of Queen Anne's county, deceased, was referred, reported the said bill with amendments.

On motion, the senate took up the second reading of the said bill, and passed the same with the following amendments.

Amendments proposed. In the 2d line from the bottom of the 1st page strike out the word "collection" and insert "collecting the fees so due to the said sheriff for services by him performed." Strike out from the last word "the" in the last line of the same page to the word "in" in the 1st line of the 2d page, and insert the word "same." In the 5th line from the bottom of the 2d page, after the word "persons" insert "as shall be." In the 5th line of the 3d page, after the word "O'Bryon" insert "and that is doth not appear from the said books or papers, or by any memorandum of the said Thomas O'Bryon, that any part or parcel of the charges contained in such account hath been paid, or otherwise secured or satisfied." In the 4th line of the 5th page strike out the words "fair and just" and insert "equal."

The bill, entitled, An act to prohibit the raising or going at large of geese and swine within the limits of the town of Saint Michael's, in Talbot county, and for other purposes therein mentioned, was read the second time and will not pass.
