

the said Jarrett of the intendant of the revenue, and for which land he the said Jarrett hath paid the state at the rate of four shillings per acre, with interest thereon; therefore, **RESOLVED**, That the chancellor, on the application of the said Jesse Jarrett, be and he is hereby authorised to examine into the truth of the above allegations, and if in his opinion the said Jarrett is entitled to a return of the purchase money aforesaid, or interest, or to pay any part thereof, and shall so decree, then and in that case the state shall pay to him the said purchase money, or such part thereof, with interest, if any be allowed, as on a consideration of the opinion of the court of appeals, and of all other circumstances, shall appear to the chancellor reasonable and just.

AND RESOLVED, That the treasurer of the western shore pay to the said Jarrett, such sum, or sums of money, if any, as shall be decreed to be paid by the chancellor to the said Jesse Jarrett; and agreeably to, and in conformity with, the directions of such decree.

THE senate met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The bill, entitled, An act to change the place of holding elections in the fourth election district of Montgomery county, was read the second time, passed, and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

The bill, entitled, An act authorising the late collectors of public taxes in Cecil county to complete their several collections, was read the second time, passed, and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

The amendments proposed by the house of delegates to the bill, entitled, An act to reduce into one the several acts of assembly respecting elections, and to regulate said elections, were read the second time, concurred with, and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

The bill, entitled, An act compelling the proprietors of lots binding on the water at the west end of the basin in the city of Baltimore to extend and improve the same, and the bill, entitled, An act for the benefit of Andrew Hamilton, of Prince-George's county, were severally read the second time, passed, and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

Mr. J. Johnson, from the committee, delivers a bill, entitled, An act to suspend the operation of the part of the act of assembly therein mentioned; which was read the first and second time by especial order, passed, and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

The bill, entitled, An act relating to the inspection of tobacco not the growth of this state, was read the second time, passed, and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

The bill, entitled, An act for erecting a town at or near the mouth of Will's creek, in Allegany county, was read the second time, passed, and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

The bill, entitled, An act to provide for the erection of a new court-house for Baltimore county, and the bill, entitled, An act to authorise and empower the levy court of Anne Arundel county to assess a sum of money for the purpose therein mentioned, were severally read the second time, passed, and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

The bill, entitled, A further supplement to an act for the more effectual collection of the county charges in Allegany county, was read the second time and will not pass. Sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

The bill, entitled, An act to prevent free negroes from selling any corn, wheat, tobacco or other articles, without having a licence for that purpose from a justice of the peace, was read the second time, passed with the proposed amendments, and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

Amendments proposed. 1. After the word "wheat" in the title of the bill insert "or," and strike out the words "or other articles." 2. After the word "wheat" in the 5th line of the 1st page insert "and," and strike out the words "and articles of provisions" in the same line. 3. After the word "wheat" in the 8th line of the 1st page insert "or," and strike out the words "or any articles of provisions" in the following line. 4. Strike out the words "or any article of provision" in the 4th line of the second page.

The bill, entitled, An act authorising the chancellor in certain cases to decree conveyances for land, the title to which is in British subjects, was read the second time, passed with the proposed amendments, and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

Amendments proposed. 1. After the word "subjects" in the 6th line of the 1st page insert "or vested by law in this state." 2. After the word "subject" in the 2d line of the 2d page insert "or vested by law in this state."

On motion, **ORDERED**, That the report of the committee of conference be recommitted to the said committee. Mr. M'Calloch and Mr. Shryer have leave of absence for the remainder of the session.

The bill, entitled, An additional supplement to an act, entitled, An act to extend the powers of the levy court of Allegany county relative to roads in said county, was read the second time, passed, and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.
