- The clerk of the house of delegates delivers the engrossed bills from No. 76 to 95, and from 97 to 110, severally assented to by that house December 24, 1808; which were severally read, assented to, and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

The bill, entitled, An act to incorporate the convention of the protestant episcopal church in Maryland, was read the second time by especial order and will not pass. Sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

The clerk of the house of delegates returns the bill, entitled, A further supplement to the act, entitled, An act to regulate and discipline the militia of this state, endorsed, "By the house of delegates, December 24, 1808: Read the first and second time by especial order and will pass." Ordered that the said bill be engrossed.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivers a bill, entitled, An act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from near Ellicott's lower mills to Georgetown in the district of Columbia, passed by that house December 24, 1808; and the following resolutions:
