

An act authorising the levy of a sum of money upon the assessable property of Queen Anne's and Caroline counties for the purpose of building a bridge over the head waters of Luckahoe creek, because we are of opinion that the levy courts of Queen Anne's and Caroline counties now have all the powers necessary for carrying into effect the object of the said bill; which powers and authorities are contained in an act of assembly, passed at November session seventeen hundred and ninety four. chapter fifty-three.

Swearingen, Shriver and T. Jones be a committee to prepare and bring in the same.

On motion by Mr. Quinton, leave given to bring in a bill entitled, An act to change the mode of repairing the public roads in Worcester county. *Ordered*, That Messrs. Quinton, Wilson and Handy be a committee to prepare and bring in the same.

On motion by Mr. C. Dorsey, *Ordered*, That the bill respecting the equity jurisdiction of the county courts, have a second reading on the 3d December next.

Mr. Randall delivers the bill annulling the marriage of James Irvin of Washington county, and a bill entitled, An act annulling the marriage of Susanna Stewart of Baltimore county; which were read.
