

VOTES AND PROCEEDINGS

On motion by Mr. Herbert, the question was put, that the first clause be stricken out, to wit :

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland That William M. Mecken, Joseph Young, Robert Stewart, William Pechin, Samuel R. Smith, William B. Barney, Ludwig Her-ring, George Sules and Christian Slimmer, or the majority of them, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners to open and extend said Pratt street, of a convenient width, from Light street, eastwardly to Jones' falls; and that the said street, when so opened and extended, shall forever thereafter be, and remain a public street and highway; and the said commissioners are hereby required to cause an accurate plot thereof to be made and returned to the register's office of the city of Baltimore; who shall receive and file the same among the records of his office, as a part of the plot of the city of Baltimore. Determined in the negative.

On motion of Mr. Herbert, the question was put, That the following be inserted after the sixth clause, to wit :

"AND BE IT ENACTED, That the persons injured as aforesaid, shall be entitled to receive respectively a principal or capital, which at six per cent, will produce or amount to what the said property shall or would rent for." Determined in the negative.

On motion by Mr. Herbert, the question was put, That the following be inserted in the tenth clause after the word, "advisable" to wit :

"And the persons injured as aforesaid, shall be and they are hereby entitled to a right of pre-emption in purchasing the wharf or slip, to be extended under this law, from the south side of Pratt street, at a valuation to be made by the commissioners aforesaid; and in case there shall be more of the persons offering than there are lots on said wharf, then the commissioners hereby authorised to sell the same, shall be authorised to determine by lot, who shall be the purchaser or purchasers.
