So it was resolved in the affirmative.

On motion by Mr. Willis the question was put, That the bill to incorporate a bank to be called by the name of the Farmers' Bank of Somerset and Worcester counties, be referred to the next General Assembly? Determined in the negative.

The house proceeded to the second reading of the said bill; which being read throughout, on motion by Mr. Wilson the title was amended by striking out the word "counties." On motion by Mr. Little, the question was put, That the following be added to the said bill:

"And be it enacted, That the president, directors and company of said bank shall pay to the treasurer of the Eastern Shore, twenty-five cents, annually, on every hundred dollars of the actual capital stock of said bank, to be applied to the use and support of public schools in this state?
