Mr. Callis delivers a petition from Edward Mahorney, of Prince George's county, a revolutionary soldier, praying relief; which was read and referred to Messrs. Callis, Belt and F. Hall.

Mr. A. Dorsey delivers a bill entitled, An act to authorise and empower John Stringer, of Anne-Arundel county, to execute deeds of conveyance for the real estate therein mentioned.

Mr. Frisby delivers a bill entitled, An additional supplement to the act entitled, An act authorising the drawing of a lottery to defray the expense of building a Masonic Hall in the city of Baltimore.

Mr. F. Hall delivers a bill entitled, An act for the relief of Dennis M. Burgess, an insolvent debtor, of Prince George's county.

Mr. Howard delivers a bill entitled, An act authorising a lottery to raise a sum of money to improve the road leading from Western Port, in Allegany county, to Morgan town, where the same crosses the mountain between George's creek and Savage river; and Mr. Z. Duvall delivers a bill entitled, An additional supplement to the act entitled, An act to repair the old, or to build a new poor's-house in Anne-Arundel county ; which were severally read.

The bill for the relief of Aquila Miles, of Harford county ; the bill to regulate the inspection of salted fish in this state ; and the bill authorising Elizabeth Luckett, of Frederick county to remove certain negroes into the state of Maryland, were severally read the second time, passed and sent to the senate.
