On motion by Mr. Wilson, That the following be added to the said bill :

"AND BE IT ENACTED, That the said banks in the city of Baltimore, before this act shall be considered in operation, and enuring to continue the said charters, shall elect and bind themselves to pay into the treasury of the Western Shore, the sum of _____ for each and every year during the continuance of their respective charters, as aforesaid under this law; the sum so as aforesaid to be paid by the said banks, shall be in proportion to their respective capitals actually paid or to be paid in; and which sums as aforesaid, shall be and they are hereby pledged as a fund for the purposes of supporting county schools.

AND BE IT ENACTED, That it shall be the duty of the treasurer of the Western Shore to demand of the said banks their respective quota of the said sum, on the first day of January in each and every year during the continuance of this act, after the first day of January eighteen hundred and sixteen."

On motion by Mr. Stevens, the question was put, That the blank be filled up with "ten thousand dollars?" Determined in the negative.

The question was then put, on "eight thousand dollars?" Determined in the negative.

The question was then put on "seven thousand dollars?"
