purposes therein mentioned; and a bill entitled. An act authorising the levy court of Washington county to appoint commissioners to lay off the road therein mentioned, severally passed by that house, November 13, 1811; which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table. The bill entitled, An act for the benefit of Alexander Rigdon, of Harford county, was read the second time and will pass with the proposed amendments.

Amendments proposed.

1st. Strike out the preamble.

2d. Strike out the words "carrying the said," in the 3d line of the 2d page, and insert "certain commissioners having located

and opened a."

3d. Strike out the words, "award accordingly" in the 9th line of the 2d page, and insert "return the same to the levy court of Harford county."

The following message was read and agreed to:

On motion, leave given to bring in a bill entitled, An act relative to the inspection of tobacco in the city of Baltimore. Ordered, That Messrs. Levi Hollingsworth, Dorsey and Brown be a committee to prepare and bring in the same.

The bill entitled, An act to authorise and empower the justices of the levy court of Caroline county to discontinue so much of the public road as is therein mentioned, was read the second.
