TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 26, 1811.

THE Senate met -Present the same members as on yesterday The proceedings of yesterday were read.

Mr. Bruce and Mr. Dorsey appeared in the Senate.

The bill entitled, An act to repeal the fourth and fifth sections of an act entitled, A supplement to the act entitled, An act to regulate the inspection of tobacco, was read the second time, passed and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

The resolution relative to Kilty's reports of the English statutes, was read the second time by special order, assented to and sent to

the house of delegates by the clerk.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivers a bill entitled, An act to repeal the third section of an act entitled, An act continuing mact relating to costs in criminal cases; a bill entitled, An act to anthorise and empower the levy court of Anne-Arundel county wassess and levy a sum of money for the purpose therein mentioned, severally passed by that house November 25, 1811; a bill entitled, A supplement to the act entitled, An act authorising commissioners to make sale of the land of which William Warman Berry died possessed; and a bill entitled, A further supplement to the act entitled, An act to regulate the inspection of tobacco, ieverally passed by that house November 26, 1811; which were everally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

The bill entitled, An act for the benefit of John Deitrick Krantz of Frederick county, was read the second time and will pass

with the proposed amendments.

Amendments proposed.

1st. Strike out from the word " acquired" in the twelfth line of the first page to the word "provided" in the second line of the second page, and insert "be and the same is hereby as amply and fally vested in the said John Deitrick Krantz and his heirs to all intents and purposes, as it would have been if he had been dely
