Messrs. Bruce and Dorsey appeared in the senate.

The bill entitled, A supplement to the act of seventeen hundred eighty five, and the supplementary acts thereto, which provide for the poor of Dorchester county, was read the second time, and will pass with the proposed amendments.

Amendments proposed.

1st. Strike out the word "which" in the eleventh line of the first page and insert "who."

2nd. Strike out the word "whom" in the third line of the second page and insert "who."

3rd. Strike out from the word "enacted" in the first line of the third page to the end of the clause, and insert "that the trustees in their discretion may provide for any number of out-pensioners, any law to the contrary notwithstanding."

The bill entitled, An act for the relief of Robert D. Allen, of the city of Baltimore, was read the second time by special order and will pass.

The bill entitled, An act to empower the justices of the levy court of Cecil county to appoint commissioners to review, alter and amend the road therein mentioned; and the bill entitled, An act to authorise a lottery for the purpose therein mentioned in Washington county, were severally read the second time, and will pass.
