Which were severally read the first time and the bills ordered to lie on the table.

The senate proceeded to said election, and the ballot box being prepared the ballots were deposited therein, sealed up and delivered to the committee of the senate appointed to meet the committee of the house of delegates; who retired to the conference room, and after some time returned and reported that James Caldwell had sixty six votes, and Elias Glenn fifty-five votes for directors in the Union Bank of Maryland; that Tobias E. Stansbury had sixty votes and Peter Little fifty-eight votes for directors in the Mechanics Bank of Baltimore; that William Kilty had sixty votes and Nicholas Brewer fifty-seven votes for directors in the Farmers' Bank of Maryland, at Annapolis; that David Kerr, jun. had fifty-eight votes and Jacob Gibson fifty-seven votes for directors in the Branch Bank at Easton, and that Thomas B. Hall had sixty votes for director in the Hager's-Town Bank. Whereupon it is declared in the senate, that James Caldwell and Elias Glenn for the Union Bank of Maryland; Tobias E. Stansbury and Peter Little for the Mechanics Bank of Baltimore; William Kilty and Nicholas Brewer for the Farmers' Bank of Maryland at Annapolis; David Kerr, jun. and Jacob Gibson for the Branch Bank at Easton, and Thomas B. Hall for the Hager's Town Bank, are duly elected directors on the part of the state, for and during the term prescribed by law.

The bill entitled, An act to lay out and open a road in Prince George's county and for other purposes, was read the second time and will pass with the proposed amendments.
