11th. Strike out the words "William MacCreery" in the tenth line of the fifth page and insert "David Williamson, Alexander MacDonald, David Winchester."

12th. Strike out the word "commissioners" in the twelfth line of the fifth page and insert "assessors."

13th. Strike out the word "commissioners" in the fifth line of the sixth page and insert "assessors"

14th. Strike out the word "commissioners" in the seventh line of the sixth page and insert "assessors."

15th. Strike out the letter "a" at the end of the seventh line of the sixth page and insert "an."

16th. Strike out the words "commissioner or commissioners" in the eighth line of the sixth page and insert "assessor or assessors."

17th. Strike out the words "commissioner or commissioners" in the eleventh line of the sixth page and insert "assessor or assessors."

18th. Strike out the word "commissioners" in the twelfth line of the sixth page and insert "assessors." Resolved in the affirmative.

The question was then put, Will the senate adjourn? Resolved in the affirmative.
