The bill entitled, An act for the encouragement of learning in Cecil county was sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

Mr. Bruce from the committee delivers a bill entitled, An act to establish a bank and incorporate a company under the name of the Cumberland Bank of Allegany; which was read the first and second time by special order, passed and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

The bill entitled, A supplement to an act entitled, An act relating to the public roads in the several counties therein mentioned, was read the second time, passed with the proposed amendment and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.
