The resolution in favor of the West-Nottingham Academy was read the second time by special order and assented to.

The resolution in favor of Saint Peters' school; and the resolution in favor of the Hager's-town Academy, were severally read the second time and assented to.

The bill entitled, An act for the encouragement of learning in Harford county, was read the second time by special order and will pass.
