

The bill entitled, an act for the benefit of certain persons who immigrated into or settled in this state before the adoption of the constitution of the United States, and the bill entitled, a further additional supplement to the act entitled, an act for the better regulation of apprentices, were severally read the second time, passed and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

The resolution in favor of James Butcher, and others, was read the second time by special order, assented to, and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

The bill entitled, an act to alter and change the place of holding the elections in the first election district in Kent county, was read the second time, and will not pass. Sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

On motion of Mr. L. Hollingsworth, leave given to bring in a bill entitled, an act extending the benefit of the insolvent laws to certain petitioners therein mentioned. *Ordered*, that Messrs. L. Hollingsworth, N. Williams, and Hawkins be a committee to prepare and bring in the same.

Mr. L. Hollingsworth from the committee delivers a bill entitled, an act extending the benefit of the insolvent laws to certain petitioners therein mentioned; which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

The bill entitled, an act to change the mode of repairing the public roads in Caroline county, was read the second time, and will pass with the proposed amendments.

Amendments proposed.

1st. After the word "nuisances" in the 5th line of the 7th page, insert "or impediments."

2nd. After the word "nuisances" in the 17th line of the 7th page insert "or impediments."

The clerk of the house of delegates delivers a bill entitled, an act to authorise the levy court of Baltimore county, to assess and levy a sum of money for the purposes therein mentioned, passed by that house, Jan. 13, 1814, and a bill entitled, an act for the relief of Wm. Patterson, Wm. Smith, Wm. Cooke and others, passed by that house, Jan. 14, 1814; which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

The senate met. — Present the same members as on yesterday. — The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The bill entitled, an act to change the mode of repairing the public roads in Caroline county, and the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to lay out and make public a road in Somerset county, passed in November session, 1812, were sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

The bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act entitled, an act to authorise the filling up and extending of certain lots on the south side of the Basin, in the city of Baltimore, was read the second time, passed with the proposed amendments, and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

Amendments proposed.

1st. Strike out the word "running" in the 2d line of the 2d page, and insert "which street shall run."

2nd. Strike out the words "not exceeding" in the 4th line of the second page, and insert "shall be of the width of fifty feet, and not more than"

3rd. After the word "and" in the 5th line of the 2nd page insert "that the said Christopher Hughes and any other persons who now are or hereafter may be proprietors as aforesaid."

4th. Strike out the word "North" in the 2d line of the 3rd page, and insert "South."

5th. After the word "streets," in the 8th line of the 3rd page, insert "and the said street called Quay street, of the width aforesaid, and extending from Forrest street to Johnson street."

6th. At the end of the bill add "provided always, and be it enacted, that the mayor and city council of Baltimore, shall be, and hereby are authorised and empowered to fill up and wharf out at the expense of the said city, the aforesaid spaces of twenty two and an half feet in front of the said streets called William street and Johnson street, on the West sides thereof, and in that case shall be entitled to the wharfrage thereon as public wharves, on condition that the said mayor and city council shall elect to do so at their next annual session after the passing of this act, and shall commence the said work before the month of June following, and shall complete the same so far as relates to William street, on or before the first day of January, eighteen hundred and fifteen, and so far as relates to Johnson street, in the course of that year, and not otherwise; in default whereof the said Christopher Hughes, or other persons entitled as aforesaid, shall have the privileges and powers relative to the said spaces which are herein before provided."

The bill entitled, an act authorising Matthias Shaaliner, late sheriff of Washington county, to complete his collections, was read the second time, passed with the proposed amendment, and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

Amendment proposed.

Strike out the words "a copy of" in the 7th line of the second page.
