

The senate resumed the consideration of the bill, entitled, An act for the relief of Richard M. J. Anson of the city of Baltimore, and on further consideration will not pass.

The bill, entitled, An act to incorporate Westminster, in Frederick county, was read the third time and will pass with the proposed amendments, and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

Amendments proposed. 1. In the 1st line 2d section strike out the word "and" and insert "an." 2. strike out from the word "impleaded," 4th line 2d section to the end of the section.

The bill, entitled, An act authorising Marsham Parker, former sheriff of Calvert county, to complete his collection, was read the second, and by special order the third time, and will pass. The bill, entitled, An act for the relief of Walter Edelen, of Charles county, was read the second, and by special order the third time, and will not pass. The bill, entitled, An act to prevent swine from going at large in the town of Salisbury, was read the second, and by special order the third time, and will pass. The bill, entitled, An act declaring the continuation and extension of the charter of the Elkton Bank of Maryland, was read the second, and by special order the third time, and will pass. Severally sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

The bill, entitled, An act for the further compensation to jurors in Harford county, was passed by the senate with amendments, and returned to the house of delegates, and was again returned by that house, with a message requesting the amendments to be receded from, and on reconsideration were receded from, and the bill returned to the house of delegates, by the clerk, with the following message:

BY THE SENATE, February 5, 1819.

Gentlemen of the House of Delegates,

We have receded from the amendments proposed to the bill, entitled, An act for the further compensation of jurors in Harford county, and return it to your honourable body, passed in accordance with the wishes expressed in your message.

The bill, entitled, A supplement to an act, entitled, An act to establish a bank and incorporate a company under the title of The Planters Bank of Prince-George's County, was read the second and third time by special order and will pass. The bill, entitled, An act for the relief of Thomas Wilson, of Caroline county, was read the second, and by special order the third time, and will not pass. Severally sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

The bill, entitled, An act to repeal the act, entitled, An act for the encouragement of such persons as will undertake to build water mills, was read the third time and will not pass, and sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

The bill, entitled, An act to regulate the measurement of oats in the several counties therein mentioned, passed by the house of delegates, and sent to the senate for concurrence, who proposed sundry amendments thereto, which were disagreed to by the house of delegates, and returned to the senate with a message requesting them to recede from the said amendments. The bill was again returned to the house of delegates, with the following message:

BY THE SENATE, February 5, 1819.

Gentlemen of the House of Delegates,

The senate received your message accompanying the bill, entitled, An act to regulate the measurement of oats. The senate insist on their amendments.

On motion of Mr. Carmichael, Leave given to bring in a bill, entitled, An act incorporating The Baltimore Lying-in and Foundling Hospital. Ordered, That Messrs. Carmichael, Parham and Emerson, be a committee to prepare and bring in the same.

Mr. Carmichael from the committee reported said bill; which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

The bill, entitled, An act to annul the marriage of George Bradshaw, and Martha Bradshaw his wife, of Washington county, was read the second and by special order the third time and will not pass. Sent to the house of delegates by the clerk.

The bill, entitled, An act for the relief of Peter Kemp, of Frederick county, was read the second, and by special order the third time, and will pass with the proposed amendment, and sent to the house of delegates.

Amendment proposed. 1. After the word "Maryland" strike out to the end of the bill, and insert: "That the levy court of Frederick county be and they are hereby authorised and empowered, on the application of the said Peter Kemp, to appoint three disinterested freeholders of Frederick county, to ascertain what damages, if any, the said Peter Kemp has sustained by reason of the said road having been located and opened through his lands. And the said freeholders are hereby required to consider the convenience, benefit, advantages and disadvantages, occasioned by opening said road, and to return, under their hands, the valuation made by them to the levy court aforesaid, who shall levy the amount ascertained, if any, on the assessable property of said county, to be collected and paid to the said Peter Kemp, his executors or administrators. And be it enacted, That the said freeholders, before they act as such, shall take an oath to value the damages, if any, sustained by the said Peter Kemp, without favour, affection, or partiality."

The bill, entitled, An additional supplement to the act to establish and incorporate a Medical and Chirurgical Faculty or Society in the state of Maryland, was read the second, and by special order the third time, and will not pass.

On motion, the senate agreed to reconsider said bill; on reconsideration will pass with the proposed amendment:

Amendment proposed. At the end of the bill add the following: "And be it enacted, That no person residing out of this state, shall be permitted to practise therein, in medicine or surgery, without being subject to the same regulations, and liable to the same penalties, imposed on persons resident in this state, by any law to the contrary notwithstanding."

On motion of Mr. Taney, the following amendment was adopted: Strike out the title and insert the following: "An additional supplement to the act, entitled, An act to establish and incorporate a Medical and Chirurgical Faculty or Society in the state of Maryland."
