GENTLEMEN—In regard to a view of the proceedings of our court, within the three years mentioned in the order, I can say but little certain as to the portion of the time taken up by the court: the criminal cases are generally taken up as soon as the prosecutor and the parties are ready; when there are no criminal cases ready the court proceeds with the other business. The time allotted by the court for hearing appeals from magistrates' judgment, is the first Friday in each term, but generally does not take more than half the day; there are none of the cases that have been sent to the court of appeals during the last three years returned. On procedendo I do not know how many have been affirmed.

The time of the sitting of our court is generally from nine in the morning until three o'clock in the evening; there are no adjournments of the court, only at the time of rising each evening, except on the last day of the term, when it is usual to adjourn until the evening to receive the sheriff's returns on the judicial docket;
