ments, three hundred and sixty four appearances, one hundred and seventeen of which were renewals, one hundred and twenty five criminal appearances, ninety two criminal continuances and sixty two presentments found at that term. Of the references, four were judgments, three struck off and ninety continued. Equity cases, five continued. Appeals, three were judgments affirmed, two judgments reversed, one entered agreed, five dismissed and ten continued.

Trials—three of which were tried, one instituted to April 1813, one to April 1818, one to Sept. 1819. One hundred and thirty three judgments concessed, eight of which were removed to the court of appeals, three struck off, nive entered agreed, twenty three non pross'd, one entered settled, ten entered satisfied, and one hundred and fifteen continued, two of which con-

tinued under rule argument.

That on the docket of September, eighteen hundred and twenty, there were nincty references. five equity cases, fitteen appeals from justices of the peace, five of which were to that term, two hundred and forty two trials, one hundred and sixty imparlances, sixty two amerciaments, three hundred and thirty seven appearances, one hundred and eight of which were renewals, one hundred and twenty nine criminal appearances, seventy two criminal continuances, twenty two presentments found at that term. Of the references, 2 were judgments, 9 struck off, eight entered abased, and seventy one continued. Equity cases, five continued. Appeals, five judgments reversed, one entered abated, and nine continued.
