THURSDAY, December 29th, 1825.

The senate met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The message relating to the printing for the present session, and the message in answer to that from the house of delegates, proposing the appointment of a joint committee to wait on his excellency the governor, were sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Thomas appeared in the senate.

The resolution in favor of the governor and council, was read a second and third time by special order, rejected and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Chambers offered the following message, which was read, assented to, and sent to the house of delegates

BY THE SENATE, December 29th, 1825.

*Gentlemen of the House of Delegates,*

We have rejected your resolution relative to the salary of the governor and members of the council for the time of their service, directed by the act of the last session.

We are of opinion that the resolution should direct particularly, the sum to be paid to each of the officers in it, and having no authority to alter the terms of the resolution, have been compelled to reject it, with a view to bring the subject to your notice.

The bill to confirm an act, entitled an act for the relief of the Jews in Maryland, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-four, was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Kent appeared in the senate and took his seat. On motion by Mr. Chambers, leave was given to bring in a bill to be entitled "an additional supplement to the act entitled 'an act directing the manner of serving out attachments in this province, and limiting the extent of them. Ordered, that Messrs. Chambers, Kent and Orrell, should prepare and report the same.
