Mr. Johnson presented the memorial of Solomon Etting, of the city of Baltimore, praying for a law to authorise him to improve a lot in Pine street, in the said city, as laid down by the commissioners appointed under the act of December session, 1818, to locate streets, lanes, and alleys, which was read and referred to Messrs. Johnson, Miller, and Claude.

Mr. Johnson asked and obtained leave to bring in a bill to be entitled "an act for the amendment of the law." Ordered that Messrs. Johnson, Orrell and Tilghman, be a committee to

prepare and report the same.

Mr. Brownley presented the petition of Samuel Lee, of Harford county, praying for support. Which was read and referred to Messrs. Brownley, Miller and Quinton. Mr. Brownley from the committee to whom the said petition was referred, reported a hill for the support of Samuel Lee, of Harford county, which was read the first time and laid on the table.

Mr. Tilghman from the committee made an unfavorable report upon the bill to lay out and make public a road in Baltimore county. The bill was then read a second, and by special order a third time rejected and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill for the relief of Catharine Tennison, of the city of Baltimore, was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed.

Mr. Miller from the committee reported a bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to lay out and make public two roads therein mentioned, in Cecil county, which was read the first time and laid on the table.

The resolutions relative to the election of president and vicepresident, was read a third time, unanimously assented to, and

returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Johnson from the committee to whom was referred the bill to authorize John Mc Tavish to act as executor to Charles Carroll, of Carrollton, reported that the committee has had the same under consideration, and were of opinion that it ought to pass with the following amendments, viz: 1st, after the word "McTavish," in the second line of the section, insert "one of the." 2d, after the word "as," in the fourth line, insert "one of the." 3d, add as an additional section, "and be it enacted, that this act shall be void and of no effect, unless there be a citizen or citizens of the United States, appointed co-executor or co-executors with the said John Mc Tavish to the said last will." 4th. After the word "as," in the title, insert the words "one of the."

Which amendments were read, and assented to. The bill was then read a second, and by special order a third time, passed with the proposed amendments, and returned to the house of

delegates.

The supplement to an act to lay out and make public two roads therein mentioned, in Cecil county, was read a second and third time by special order, passed, and sent to the house of delegates.
