my of Baltimore; which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Johnson, Claude and Miller.

Also, the ingressed bill from No. 40 to No. 65, inclusive; which were read, assented to, and returned to the house of del-

egates.

The bill entitled, an act regulating appeals from magistrates courts, was read a third time, amended, passed with the proposed amendments and returned to the house of delegates. Amendments proposed, viz: strike out the word "courts," in the title of the bill, and insert "judgments."

The clerk of the council delivered the following communication, which was read with the accompanying act, and referred to

Miller, Johnson and Brownley.

Mr. Johnson asked and obtained leave to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act relating to Baltimore county court. Ordered,
