session 1805, chapter 52 was read the third time, passed, and

returned to the house of delegates.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a bill entitled, an act for the delivery of the will of Solomon Kitt, which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Thomas, Scott and Miller.

Also, a bill entitled, an act relating to the owners and occupants of shad and herring fisheries on the Potomac river, which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Bowie, Thomas and Miller.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to protect the breed of fish in the rivers and waters of Anne Arundel county, which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Claude, Dickinson and Orrell.

The senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 c'clock.

Thursday, February 16th, 1826.

The senate met. Present the same members as on yester-

day. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The resolution in favor of the Catholic Chapel in the city of Annapolis, was read a second and by special order, a third time, assented to, and returned to the house of delegates.

The supplement to the act entitled, a supplement to the act for the establishment and regulation of levy courts, in the several counties in this state, was read a third time, rejected, and

returned to the house of delegates.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a bill entitled, a supplement to the act for the benefit of Ann Rochester, and Francis Rochester, which was read the first time, and laid on the table.

Also a bill entitled a supplement to the act, to ascertain the allowance of jurors in the several counties in this state; which was read the first time; and referred to Messrs. Scott, Claude and Brownley.

Also a bill entitled an act to provide for the payment of jurors in Frederick county; which was read the first time, and

laid on the table.

Also a bill entitled an act to empower the judges of Montgomery county court, to direct the sale of the lands therein mentioned; which was read the first time, snd referred to Messsrs. Bowie, Scott and Quinton.

Also, a bill entitled an act authorising the levy court of Washington county, to repair or rebuild the bridge over Concocheague creek at Williamsport; which was read the first time,

and laid on the table.
