Also a resolution in favor of Thomas Pollard's securities; which was read the first time, and laid on the table.

Also a resolution in favor of John Barnes, clerk of Charles county court; which was read the first, and by special order, a second time, and laid on the table.

Also a bill entitled, an act to prevent the erection of fish dams, and other obstructions across the run at Allens' Fresh, in Charles county; which was read the first, and by special order, a second and third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

Also a bill entitled, an act to make valid a deed of manumission executed by William Moffett, late sheriff of Kent county, deceased; which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs Scott, Johnson and Tilghman.

Also a bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act appointing commissioners for the regulation and improvement of the village of Hillsborough, in Caroline county; which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs Orrell, Scott and Quinton.

Also a bill entitled, an act relative to out pensioners in Charles county: which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs Miller, Orrell and Dickinson.

Also a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Seamen's Union Bethel Society, in Baltimore; which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs Johnson, Miller and Brownley.

Also a bill entitled an act for the relief of John St. Clair of Harford county, which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Brownley, Bowie and Scott.

Also a bill entitled an act, regulating fences in Harford county, which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Brownley, Quinton and Kent.

Also a bill entitled a supplement to an act, entitled, An act relating to a public landing and wharf, at a place commonly called the ship yard in Kent county, passed at December session 1824, chapter 142; which was read a first time and referred to Messrs. Emory, Scott and Bowie.

Also a bill entitled, An act to provide for the purchase of the office papers, formerly belonging to the surveyors office in Frederick county, which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Bowie, Quinton and Kent.

Also a bill entitled, An act to authorise the levy court of Frederick county, to borrow a sum of money for the purposes therein mentioned, which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Bowie, Emory and Brownley.
