

Mr. Emory made a favorable report upon the resolution in favor of Thomas Wright: the resolution was then read a second and third time, by special order, assented to, and returned to the house of delegates.

The resolution in favor of John Templeman, was read a third time, assented to and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Johnson made a favorable report upon the resolution in favor of Joseph Cresap, of Allegany county.

The resolution in favor of Conrod Coffroth, of Franklin county, Pennsylvania; and the resolution in favor of Mistress Agnes, M. Tamchel, of Allegany county, in the state of Pennsylvania.—The said resolutions were then severally read the second, and by special order, the third time, assented to and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Johnson from the committee made an unfavorable report upon the resolution in favor of Charles Bryan. The resolution in favor of James Crawford, of Frederick county, and the resolution in favor of Daniel Smith, of Frederick county.

The same were then severally read the second, and by special order: a third time, rejected and returned to the house of delegates.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered the following message, which was read.

By the House of Delegates, March 3d, 1826.

Gentlemen of the Senate,

As the session is rapidly drawing to a close, and as we are extremely desirous, that the important subjects of the honorable John C. Weems' communication referred to in a former message may be brought before the legislature by the joint committee proposed in that message; we respectfully beg leave to call the attention of your honorable body to that communication and our message relative to it; and to beg that you will, at your earliest convenience signify to us your assent to, or disagreement with our proposition for a joint committee.

Also, a resolution in favor of John Tilghman and Richard I. Jones, which was read the first, and by special order, a second and third time, amended, assented to, and returned to the house of delegates.

Amendment proposed—

At the end of the resolution, insert—

‘And provided further, That it shall be lawful for the state to issue an execution or executions, upon said judgment, in case
