

Mr. Johnson from the committee made an unfavorable report upon the bill to regulate the manner of giving public notice in cases required by law. The bill was then read a second, and by special order, a third time, rejected, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Brownley from the committee to whom was referred, the bill for the relief of John Sinclair, of Harford county, and reported, that the committee had had the same under consideration, and were of opinion that it ought to pass, with the following amendments, viz; at the end of the bill add, "provided nevertheless; that the allowance of said account of said orphans court shall have no greater or other effect than the allowance of all other accounts by said court, would in law have," which amendment was read, assented to, the bill was then read, a second and by special order, a third time, passed with the proposed amendments, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Miller from the committee made a favorable report upon the bill, to incorporate the seamens Union Bethel society of Baltimore, the bill was then read a second and by special order, a third time passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill to authorise the governor and council of Maryland, of this state, to appoint inspectors of flour in this state, was read a second and by special order, third time, and the question was put, shall the bill pass?
