

Also, the engrossed bills from No. 124 to No. 161, inclusive, which were read, assented to, and returned to the house of delegates.

And returned the bill supplementary to the act entitled, an act for founding an University in the city or precincts of Baltimore by the name of the University of Maryland; endorsed, 'will pass with the proposed amendments.'

Amendments proposed—

1st. After the word privileges, in the eighth line of the second section, insert 'confined.'

2d. Strike out from the 8th and 9th lines of the 2d section the words "together with the governor of this state for the time being."

3d. Strike out from the 10th line of the 2d section, the word "conferred" and insert the word "imposed," in lieu thereof.

4th. Add to the end of the 2d section the following "and shall also be liable and responsible as the Regents now are for all debts due by the University of Maryland, or for contracts heretofore made by the said Regents."

5th. Strike out from the 1st and 2d lines of the 6th section, the words "by lottery or otherwise or" and insert in lieu thereof, "or appropriated."

6th. Between the words 'and abolish' in the 3d line of the 8th section, insert the word "to"

7th. After the word "abolish," in the 3d line of the 8th section, insert "any professorship vacated by death or resignation."

8th. Strike out from the 1st line of the 10th section the word "eight," and insert in lieu thereof "eleven."

9th. After the 12th section, add the following additional sections.

And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of the board of trustees to make a report to the legislature of all their proceedings under this act on the first day of January annually.

And be it enacted, That nothing herein contained shall be construed to exonerate the medical professors from their obligation for the payment of interest as required by the act of 1821, chapter 88, or in any wise to impair the public security in that regard, but it shall be the duty of the said professors, and of their successors, to continue and confirm the obligation and other requisition of the said act.

And be it enacted, That this act shall go into effect and operation on the first day of June next, and not before.

Which amendments were read and laid on the table.

The bill for the promotion of internal improvement, was read a third time, and the question was put—shall the bill pass?
