

Also the supplement to an act to lay out and make public two roads therein mentioned in Cecil county, endorsed 'reconsidered, and will pass.'

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a bill entitled an act to authorise warranting on constables bonds; which was read the first, and by special order, a second time, and laid on the table.

Also a bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to authorise a lottery to raise a sum of money to clear out the creeks leading to and from Upper Marlbro, and Queen Anne, in Prince Georges county; which was read the first time and laid on the table.

Also a bill entitled an act to authorise the recovery of certain costs in suits instituted on administration and guardian bonds; which was read the first time and laid on the table.

And returned the bill concerning mortgages and other deeds endorsed 'will pass.'

The bill to authorise warranting on constables bonds, was read a second, and by special order a third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

The supplement to an act to authorise a lottery to raise a sum of money to clear out the creeks leading to and from Upper Marlbro, and Queen Anne, in Prince Georges county, was read a second time, and laid on the table.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a resolution in favor of the chaplains; which was read, assented to, and returned to the house of delegates.

Also a resolution in favor of Samuel Bradford; which was read, assented to, and returned to the house of delegates.

Also a bill entitled an act to incorporate the Susquehanna and Patapsco canal company; which was read the first and by special order a second and third time.

Mr. Miller moved to strike out the words 'or near,' in the sixth line of the eighth section, for the purpose of inserting the words 'some point between the head of tide water.' Determined in the affirmative.

On motion the name of 'John Archer,' was inserted in the 6th line of the 1st section, the bill was then passed, as amended and returned to the house of delegates.

Also, a bill entitled a supplement to the act entitled, an act, to prevent free negroes from selling any corn, wheat or tobacco, without having a license for that purpose, from a justice of the peace, which was read the first and by special order, a second and third time passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill to authorise the recovery of certain costs, in suits instituted on administration, and guardian bonds, was read a second and by special order, a third time, rejected and returned to the house of delegates.
