termined in the negative. The question was then put

"shall the bill pass." Determined in the affirmative.

The bill entitled, a further supplement to the act for enlarging the powers of the high court of chancery, was read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third read-

The clerk of the house of delegates, delivered a resolution in favour of Benjamin Tomlinson, a member of the late electoral college, reimbursing him for extraordinary expenses incurred in consequence of sickness whilst engaged in the discharge of his duties, which was read the

first time.

Also, a bill entitled, an act authorising the recording of a deed from Henry Howard (of John) to Andrew-Anderson; which was read the first time and referred to the committee on invalid deeds. Also, a bill entitled, an act extending the time for Fielder Cross, the collector of Prince George's county, to complete his collections, also, a supplement to an act entitled, an act authorising the commissioners to lay out a road in Montgomery and Anne Arundel counties, and a bill to authorise the levy court of Washington county, to levy a sum of money to be applied towards the erection of a bridge over the Conococheague creek, on the road leading from Hagerstown to Mercersburg, which were severally read the first time. Also, a bill to divorce Lucinda D. Lusby, and her husband, Thomas R. Lusby, of the city of Baltimore, which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on divorces.

Mr. Heath, from the committee, reported a bill entitled, an act to appoint a warden for the jail of Baltimore county, which was read the first time, and ordered to be printed.

The senate adjourned until Monday morning 10 o'clock.

Monday, January 15th, 1827.

The senate met. Present the same members as on Sa-

turday. The proceedings of Saturday were read.

The bill to repeal an act entitled, an act to repeal an act relating to the public roads in Talbot county, passed at December session, 1825, was read a third time, passed, and

sent to the house of delegates.

The bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act for the re-valuation of real and personal property in Alleghany county, passed at December session, 1824, was read a third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill to confirm the proceedings of the levy court of Somerset county, was read a third time, passed, and re-

turned to the house of Delegates.
