

"June" in the 7th line of the enacting clause and insert the word "March."—2d. Strike out the words "the levy courts of Worcester county," from the 8th and 9th lines of the same clause and insert the words "any two justices of the orphan's court of Worcester county."—3d At the end of the bill add the following additional section, "And be it enacted, that the said bond, so to be entered into by the said James Derickson, shall be immediately delivered by the justices of the orphan's court, who are authorised by this act to take the same, to the clerk of Worcester county court, to be by him recorded, a certified copy whereof under the seal of the said court shall be as available for all purposes as the original bond would be if produced and proved."

Which amendments were read and assented to. The bill was then read a second time.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a resolution in favour of Nehemiah Beckwith, of Dorchester county, "a resolution in favour of George Miller, of the city of Baltimore, and a resolution in favour of Benjamin Fickle, of Muskingum county, state of Ohio, which were severally read the first time and referred, to the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims.

Also, a report of the committee to whom was referred the communication addressed by the honourable John Compton Weems, to the president of the senate and speaker of the house of delegates, relative to the establishment of a naval academy, with a resolution annexed thereto, which was read the first time.
