

Mr. Sewell, from the committee, made a favourable report upon the bill to divorce William Scott, and Ann Maria Scott, of the city of Baltimore.—The said bill was then read a second time.

Mr. Johnson made a favourable report upon the bill to incorporate the Independent Fire company of the city of Baltimore.—The bill was then read a third time, and passed.

Mr. Heath asked and obtained leave to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act for the benefit of Nathaniel Smithers.—Ordered, that Messrs. Heath, Johnson and Thomas, be a committee to prepare and report the same.

Mr. Johnson from the committee, reported a bill entitled, an act to authorise the sale of a part of the real estate of James W. L. Weems, late of Prince George's county, deceased, which was read the first time.

The message proposed by Mr. Harrison, on Thursday the 1st inst: relative to the bill entitled, an act to repeal an act entitled, an act to repeal certain acts of assembly relative to amerciements, and to lay a tax on plaintiffs who may institute actions at law, was read, and referred to Messrs. Harrison, Kennedy and Heath.

The senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 o'clock.

Tuesday, February 6th, 1827.

The senate met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The bill relating to injunctions, and the bill to incorporate a company in the city of Baltimore, to be called the Independent Fire Company, were sent to the house of delegates.

The further supplement to the act for the recovery of small debts out of court, and to repeal the acts of assembly therein mentioned, was read the second time, and referred to Messrs. Herbert, Sewell and Harrison.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a resolution in favour of Charles Bryan, of Lycoming county, in the state of Pennsylvania, which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims.

Also, a bill entitled, an act for the relief of the sheriff of Caroline county, and others of said county, which was read the first time.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to establish pilots, and regulate their fees, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Johnson, Thomas, and Herbert.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Chatsworth Canal Company, which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on internal improvement.
